PARTNERSHIP COMPLETES PUBLIC FORUMS

The Peachtree Corridor Partnership completed its public forums in January, with more than 300 people attending the four meetings. The forums were held so that residents and property owners could learn more about the Partnership's vision and proposal for Peachtree Street, the first step of which is a modern streetcar system in Downtown and Midtown. It also provided an opportunity to ask questions and provide feedback into the Partnership's plans.
